


DIRECTOR OF COLLABORATIVE MINISTRIES



PROFILE

The Mosaic Conference Director of Collaborative Ministries will serve as the primary contact and team leader for accompaniment relationships with Conference-Related Ministries.

The person who fills this role will be self-directed, energetic, and dedicated. They will work well with other people, have previous non-profit ministry leadership experience and a sensitivity to the Conference's broad missional engagement through the CRM ministries. They will be curious, creative, and committed to the Conference's missional, intercultural, and formation priorities.

SKILLS NEEDED

Solid organization and community leadership skills.

Organizational abilities to coordinate a team and engage with diverse colleagues and constituent communities.

Attend core staff meetings along with all staff meetings as requested.

Serve as primary contact for new and interested CRMs.

Develop healthy mechanisms and channels for communication with CRM executives and boards.

Engage with colleagues in areas of conference priorities to empower missional, formation, and intercultural engagement with and within CRMs.
